45. APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURE FROM RESERVES FOR REPAIR WORKS TO THE SKATE RAMP AT PALEMON BEST RECREATION GROUND (Paragraph 3)

Members noted the report on the vandalism of the skate ramp at Palemon Best recreation ground, and considered the appropriate course of action to take.

It was noted that this report had been presented as any works would need to be drawn from reserves, and the management arrangements for the recreation ground were due to be reviewed.

During discussion it was noted that the council were working to make the recreation ground a pleasant recreation ground for people to use, and that it was likely to take a significant amount of work to achieve this aim. The Clerk was advised of the route followed by another Cornish local Council with a local company having provided the equipment.

RESOLVED – that the repair works to the skate-ramp at Palemon Best Recreation Group be carried out, funded from the Palemon Best earmarked reserve. The order to be placed with the supplying company unless their delivery timescales were too slow, in which case an alternative local option could be sought.
