#### FEAST SUNDAY, 9 FEBRUARY:

11.15 a.m. Mayor's Parade and Church Service

#### FEAST MONDAY, 10 FEBRUARY:

9.30 a.m. Blessing the Silver Ball

The Mayoral Procession will leave The Guildhall for the Venton Ia Well at Porthmeor and, after the short ceremony there, will return to the Parish Church by 10.30 a.m. with dancers from St Uny School, and music by Bagas Porthia. **Wet Weather Option:** Bagas Porthia will perform within the Guildhall.

10.00 a.m. Friends of the Edward Hain Memorial Hospital Coffee Morning (until midday)

10.30 a.m. Hurling of the Silver Ball

The Silver Ball is thrown from the wall of the Parish Church by the Mayor and then the person holding the Silver Ball at Noon will take it to the Mayor at The Guildhall and will receive a reward of a silver coin.

11.30 a.m. Pennies for Children under 7 years old

At the forecourt of the Guildhall

Noon Return of the Silver Ball to the Mayor, and then pennies for young people aged 7 and above

The Silver Ball is returned at the steps of the Guildhall. Pennies will be thrown from the balcony of the Guildhall.
