

DOG RESTRICTIONS ON BEACHES

Due to seasonal restrictions, dogs are not permitted at the following times on local beaches. Officers regularly patrol the beaches and can issue a £100 fine if your dog is on the beach.

Porthmeor *(blue flag)* 10am – 6pm May 15-Sept 30 *(inclusive)*

Porthminster *(seaside award)* 10am-6pm May 15 – Sept 30 *(inclusive)*

Porthgidden 10am-6pm July 1 – August 31 *(inclusive)*

St Ives harbour 10am-6pm July 1 – August 31 *(inclusive)*

Lambeth Walk *(behind West Pier by St Ia church)* – no restrictions

Bamaluz – no restrictions

- Do not let your dog invade other people's spaces
- Keep your dog safe in and around water and avoid the heat of the day
