### Statement of Reasons

St Ives Town Council proposes to make a change via a Supplemental Order, to the Order known as the St Ives Town Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment No, 1) Order 2025, pursuant to Section 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, to be known as the St Ives Town Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment No, 2) Order 2025.

The effect of the Order is to amend the St Ives Town Council (Off Street Parking Places Order) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2025 in order to vary the charges as described in the proposals below.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the Original Order, accompany this Statement of Reasons.

### Background

The new Off-Street Parking Places Order proposes an increase to the existing fees and charges in the Sloop carpark since the last increase which took effect on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025. The changes have taken into account current market conditions, and are considered to be appropriate and proportionate to current demographic and budgetary demands.

**Proposal:** to increase new tariffs which increase the charges in the Sloop Short Stay Carpark, St Ives

**Reason:** To allow for the management of demand and to offset rising operational costs, which include payment management, repair and resurfacing costs.

**Proposal:** To maintain variable tariffs with reduced charges in the Winter months

**Reason:** To support local residents and businesses

The proposed Order will include provisions in relation to the Sloop Carpark, St Ives.

The St Ives Town Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35,57 to 60 (and Part IV of Schedule 9) of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and The Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, **HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:**

3. Save as the extent to which it is amended by the subsequent Amendment Orders, the Original Order remains in full force and effect.
4. The General nature and effect of Part 1 of the First Amendment Order is as follows:-
